## SOUTHAMPTON FRESH AIR HOME CELEBRATES 125 YEARS WITH A MILESTONE PROJECT

To commemorate our 125th year, Southampton Fresh Air Home (SFAH) is planning to rebuild its Aquatics Center to better serve our campers far into the future. When the current pools were constructed in the 1990s, fewer than half required assistance to access the water. Today, more than 80% of participants use wheelchairs for mobility, and we are serving more children with complex medical conditions than ever before.

One thing, however, remains unchanged—swimming is the favorite activity of nearly every child who attends camp. The opportunity to leave their wheelchairs and experience the freedom of movement in the water is a gift of immeasurable value. It allows muscles to relax, strengthen, and move safely in ways not otherwise possible. And it is pure FUN!

The proposed new pools will have a maximum depth of five feet, ensuring that 100% of the pool is accessible to all children. By contrast, the deep end of our current pools renders approximately 60% of the space unusable for many campers. The new Aquatics Center will feature state-of-the-art lifts and fully accessible design, enabling children to enter and exit the water safely and with dignity.

We hope you will celebrate this milestone year in support of this important project by helping us raise \$1 million to create a new: Pool House, Large Activity Pool, Therapy Pool, Two Wheelchair Lifts, Shade Pergola, Landscaping, and Non-Slip Pool Hardscaping.
